Supplemental First Aid Items

(We keep a full-sized first aid kit in the camper – these are extra)

- Bandages
- Antibacterial ointment
- Cortisone anti-itch cream
- Benadryl itch relief stick
- Moleskin protective padding (for blisters)
- □ <u>Cleansing wipes</u>
- Oral thermometer

Over the Counter and Prescription Medications

- □ Ibuprofin tablets
- □ Acetominophin-Codeine tablets (left over from a procedure)
- Pepto Bismol chewable tablets
- Antihistamine (Diphenhydramine) tablets
- Decongestant (We have pseudoephedrine, which you can only buy in person)
- Urinary pain relief tablets
- Meclizine tablets (for motion sickness)
- Anti-diarrheal tablets
- □ <u>Chewable antacid tablets</u>
- Voltaren gel

Miscellaneous/Extra Stuff

- □ Hand soap (travel sized, from a longago hotel stay)
- Leatherman Micra
- Dr. Bronner's Hemp Lavender Castille Soap (can be used as hand soap, shampoo and body wash -- or dish detergent in a pinch)
- □ Hand sanitizer (travel size)
- □ <u>KN95 disposable face masks</u> (we keep a few extras in the bag)
- □ <u>Hair ties</u>
- □ Travel size toothpaste
- **Toothbrush**
- Dental floss
- Dental picks
- **Foam ear plugs**
- Lip balm
- □ <u>Magnifying compact mirror</u>
- Disposable razor
- <u>Tick remover</u>, in a small plastic bag.
